1. Executive Summary

2025 was a year of growth, resilience, and international recognition for Power in UA. Across frontline and de-occupied communities of Kharkiv region, we expanded access to clean drinking water, strengthened energy independence, supported healthcare facilities, empowered children and youth, and built global partnerships.

Total operating budget: 246,365.98 USD.

Total expenses: 186,280 USD.

Carry-over balance of ~60,000 USD allocated to 2026 projects.

2. Who We Are

Power in UA is a Ukrainian nonprofit dedicated to supporting communities affected by war, displacement, and infrastructure destruction. Our mission is to ensure access to clean water, reliable energy, healthcare, education, and safe spaces for children.

Values: Community-driven solutions; Transparency; Partnerships; Rapid implementation; Long-term resilience.

A. Clean Water Program

10 filtration stations installed across Kharkiv region.

Major partners: CUF, UCC, GlobalGiving, Corteva Agriscience, HelpingUkraine.US.



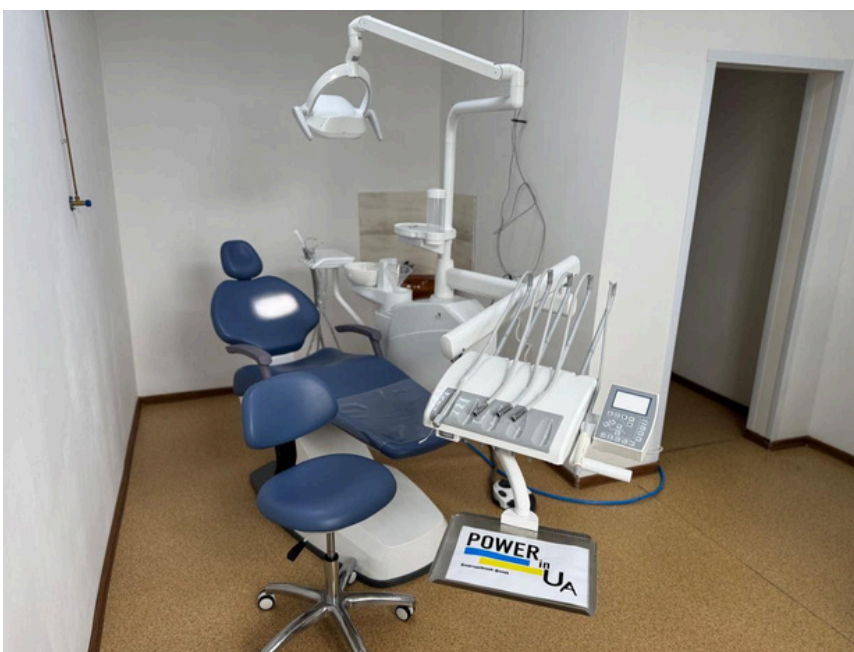
B. Energy Independence Program

65 kW solar station in Rohan; Generator delivered to Rohan community.



C. Healthcare Support

Establishment of a dental office; support for a veterans' hospital; provision of essential medical and physiotherapy equipment.



D. Community Support

Participation of children from frontline and de-occupied areas in a cultural and music festival; minitractor for Tsyrkuny; support for cultural heritage through musical and lighting equipment; support for children during Christmas and New Year holidays.



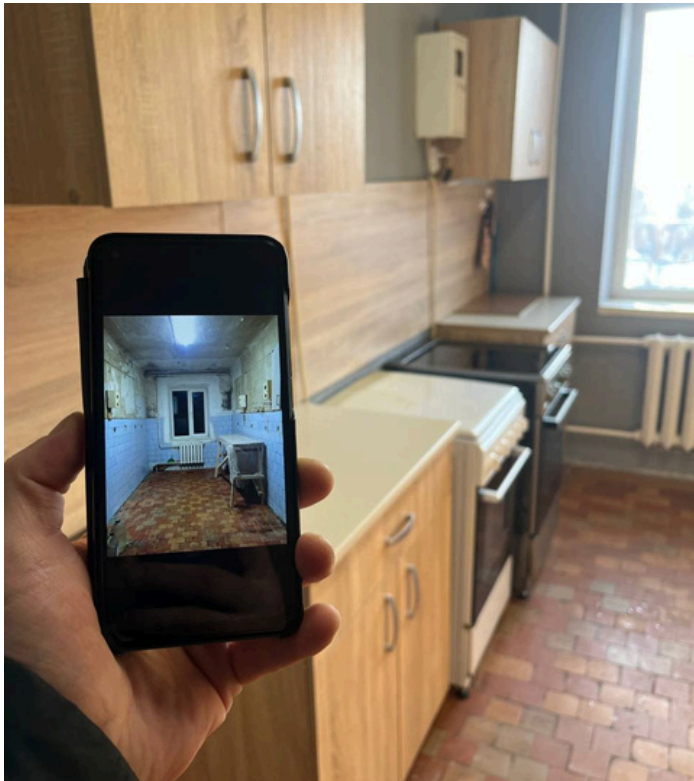
E. Sports & Youth Development

Sports ground and playground in Rohan.



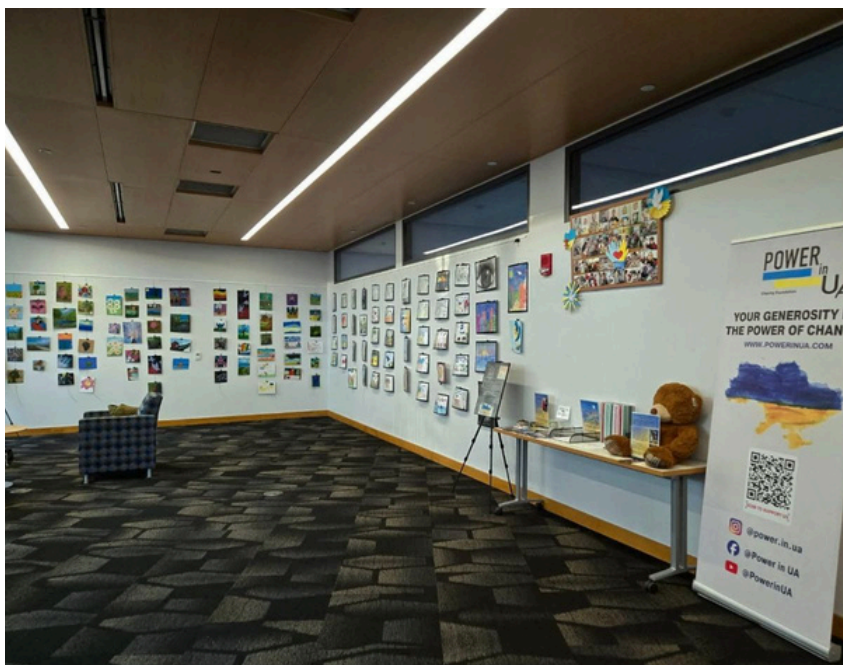
F. Support for People with Disabilities
