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MISSION AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANIZATION

Power in UA works to support communities affected by war by implementing humanitarian, medical, energy, and cultural projects.

Our mission is to provide people with clean water, medical aid, stable infrastructure, and access to cultural resources, promoting sustainable regional development.

SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE ORGANIZATION

- Installation of water purification systems
- Arrangement of mobile showers and hospitals
- Supplying hospitals with medical equipment
- Implementation of energy solutions for communities
- Support of social and cultural initiatives
- Children's programs
- Arrangement and improvement of housing for IDPs and vulnerable groups

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- Installed 7 water filtration stations providing clean water to over 50,000 people
- Set up stationary and mobile shower complexes
- Purchased medical equipment for three hospitals, including the veterans' hospital
- Procured musical instruments and equipment for children's groups in Vysochinivka and the Rogan House of Culture
- Purchased and delivered a 100 kW transformer for 137 houses in Tsyркuny village
- Installed two children's sports playgrounds
- Launched a project to replenish libraries with Ukrainian books

MAIN AREAS OF ACTIVITY

Power in UA works in the following areas:

- Water Supply and Sanitation – creating and maintaining water filtration systems
- Healthcare – providing medical facilities with equipment and resources
- Energy Independence – implementing alternative energy projects
- Humanitarian Aid – supporting vulnerable population groups
- Preservation and Development of Cultural Heritage – supporting creative initiatives, supplying libraries with books, and cultural centers with musical instruments
- Children's programs – organizing children's events and activities, installing sports playgrounds.

IMPLEMENTED PROJECTS IN THE YEAR

- Filtration Stations: 7 facilities, budget \$64,000
- Shower Complexes: 3 facilities, budget \$12,000
- Medical Aid: purchased medical equipment and furniture for two communities and a veterans' hospital, budget \$11,000
- Musical Instruments for Children: budget \$3,000
- Library Replenishment with Ukrainian Books

- Children's Physical Development: installed two children's sports playgrounds, \$3,500
- Energy Program: purchased a 100 kW transformer for 137 houses, \$3,000
- Children's Program: organized children's events in family homes for 170 children and New Year celebrations with partner communities, \$3,300
